## **ATTENDANCE POLICY:**

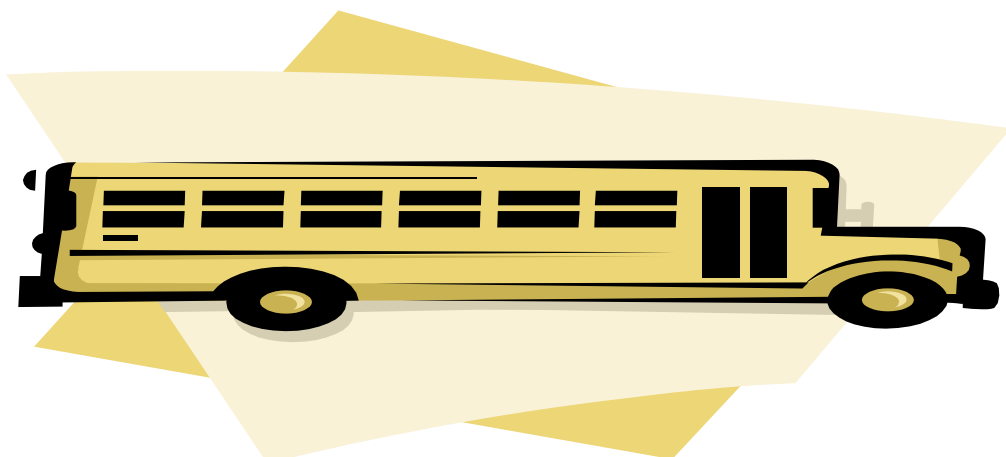
