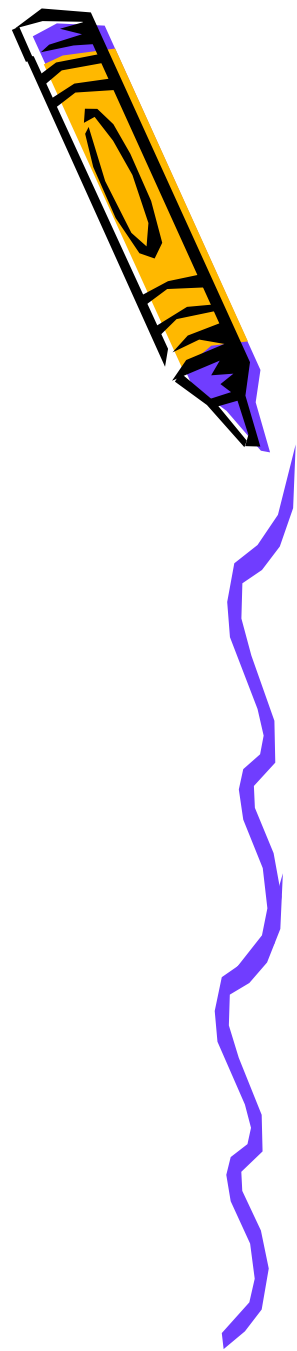

- **Grammar and Punctuation**



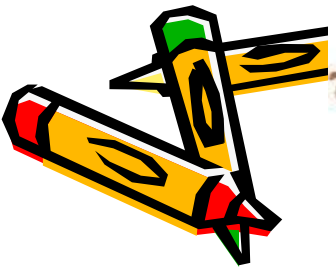

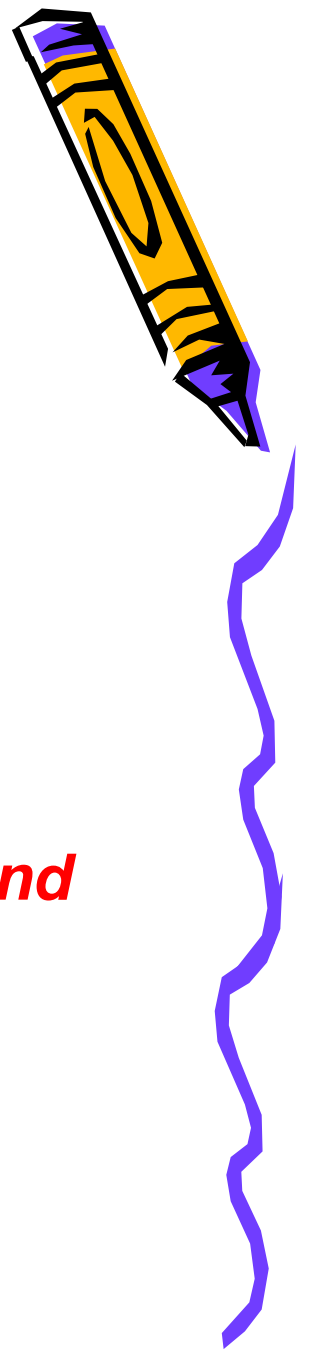


“Specials” in Year 2

Forest School



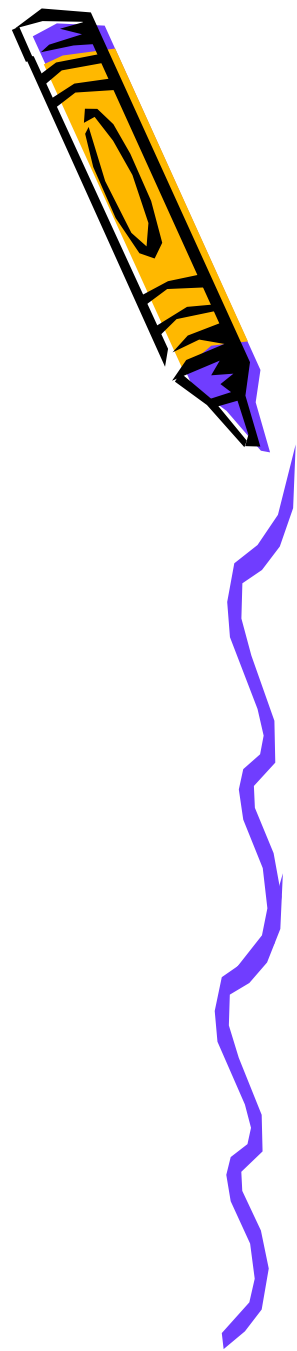
- **Monday morning (come to school dressed)**

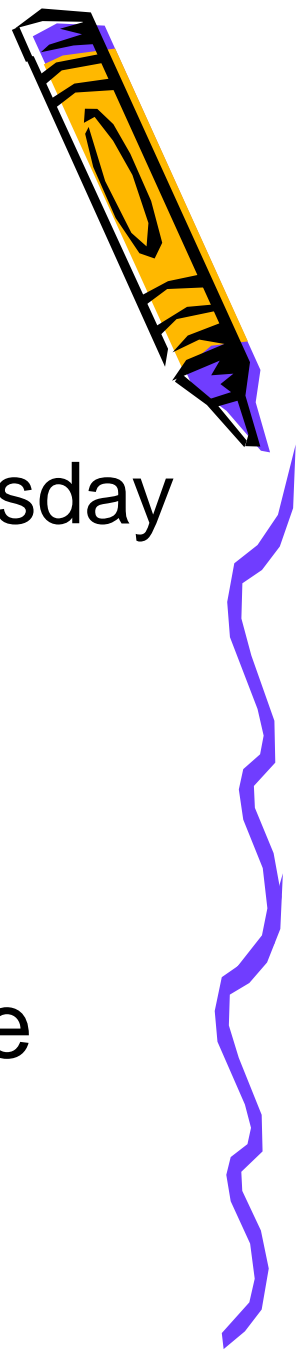
Homework

- Links to websites to use at home



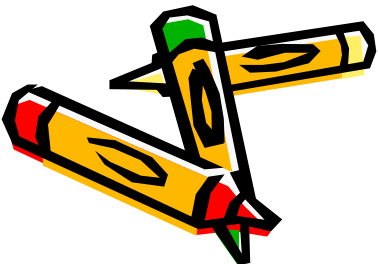
Behaviour Expectations

- Happy and safe

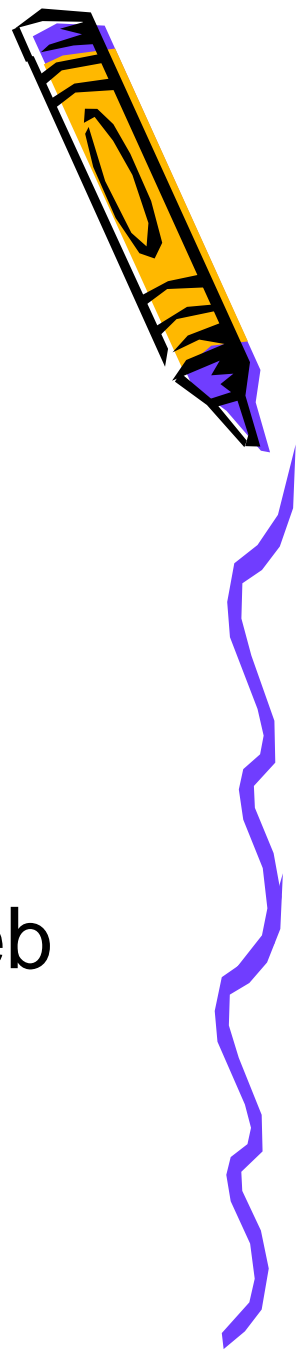


Attendance/ Appointments
