#### Science

- 1. Working Scientifically E.g. asking relevant questions, observations, reporting findings, making predictions
- 2. <u>Living Things and their habitats</u> Classifying living things and looking at changes to environments.
- 3. Animals, including humans Focus on eating: teeth, the digestive system and food chains.
- 4. States of matter Grouping materials, changing state, evaporation and condensation.
- 5. Sound Creation of sound through vibration and changes in pitch and volume.
- 6. **Electricity** Constructing a circuit and understanding conductors and insulators.




## "Specials" in Y4




# Covid Measures/ Outbreak/ Illness contingency
