- I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school, will not bring my professional role into disrepute.
- Access to the internet and school server should only be made via the authorised account and password,
   which should not be made available to any other person.
- Staff should ensure that high levels of data-protection are adhered to at all times. This means locking computers whilst leaving the room.
- Issued laptops are for staff use only.
- Users are responsible for all emails sent and for contacts made that may result in email being received.
- Use for personal financial gain, gambling, political purposes, online shopping or advertising is forbidden.
- As email can be forwarded or inadvertently be sent to the wrong person, the same professional levels
  of language and content should be applied as for letters or other media.

### Acceptable Use Agreement PARENTS

Digital technologies have become integral to the lives of children and young people, both within schools and outside school. These technologies provide powerful tools, which open up new opportunities for everyone. This Acceptable Use of IT Agreement is intended to ensure:

A copy of the Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement is attached to this permission form, so that parents/carers will be aware of the school expectations of the children in their care.

#### Permission
